- 1. Librivox** (<https://librivox.org/>) is a free audio book collection of 16,829 audio books accessible from PC, Laptop or mobile. These books can also be downloaded using Apps through Google Play Store. The complete catalogue with search interface is made available using: <https://librivox.bookdesign.biz/search.jsp?search=>. LibriVox audiobooks are free for anyone to listen to, on their computers, iPods or other mobile device, or to burn onto a CD. It was founded in 2005 by Hugh McGuire to provide "Acoustical liberation of books in the public domain" and the LibriVox objective is "To make all books in the public domain available, for free, in audio format on the internet". LibriVox Audio Books provides unlimited access to over 50,000 audio books.

Chapter-wise PDF of the book can also be downloaded and be printed. Along with each free audiobook, you'll get citation information, play time, and word count.
